Criteria

1. Selection is done according to the merit list provided by SIAC, Mumbai.
2. The table showing approved category-wise classification and number is given below for ready reference.

3. Selection is done as shown in the above table, according to reservation criteria decided by selection committee formed by State Government of Maharashtra.
4.
 - A. Apart from this any student from any reserved category getting selected in the General Merit would be considered for the seat meant for General Category.
 - B. In case of non- availability of candidate from a particular category, then candidate from next category as shown in above table can be considered.
 - C. 33% reservation has been made for ladies.
5.
 - A. It has been decided that candidates who have taken benefit of the Center and SIAC, Mumbai, previously will not be re-admitted.
 - B. List of last three year's of SIAC, students has been obtained. Proposed merit list has been cross- checked with these lists. However, if any Student found to be ex- student of the SIAC, Mumbai will not be given admission and next student will be given admission. Every student will have to give an affidavit that he has not previously taken such benefit of the institute of Government of Maharashtra.

6. Admission procedure will start from 15 December 2008 and will be completed by 17th December 2008. If some seats remain vacant, they will be filled from the waiting list as per merit and reservation criteria within a week from the date of closure of admission. (Date:- 17th December, 2008)
7. Students should come with all necessary original documents for verification for caste, domicile, Graduation, photo identity proof and two recent photographs.
8. At the time of admission, students will have to deposit Rs. 2000/- as refundable deposit.
9. Attending coaching classes and tests as per coaching plan will be compulsory and no excuses will be entertained for absence for classes and tests.
10. Students will have to give a written undertaking on stamp paper to abide by the rules and regulations of YASHADA.
